KDF Enterprises, LLC has a proven track record as a provider of services in immediate biohazard cleanup and emergency response recovery following an outbreak of the highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) viral disease, most notably during the outbreak of Avian Influenza in Iowa from 2015 to 2016.

As an experienced emergency response and management company, KDF is capable of mobilizing personnel, equipment, and resources to meet the biohazard cleanup and decontamination needs.

RAPID RESPONSE

KDF's industry hallmark is its mobilization capabilities. Over a single holiday weekend, KDF provided 800 hazmat-trained and certified employees and equipment across 50 different locations. As a result, KDF delivered a rapid and effective response, providing supervision and management with our own key personnel. Altogether, KDF provided more than \$69,000,000 worth of biohazard hazmat emergency response labor in 12 weeks.

KDF made communications with the farmers (whose livelihood had been interrupted) a priority - not because it was required but because, as the biggest stakeholders in the process, it was right to reassure them. KDF often ran extra shifts and brought in additional surge personnel to meet a farm's schedule delivery date.

Composting_-KDF has two USDA Apprentice Composting Subject Matter Experts (SME) on staff supervising our compositing teams. KDF responded, mobilized, and successfully completed multiple composting projects direct with USDA during the 2022 outbreak. We are experienced, knowledgeable and stand ready to assist your community.

<u>Cleaning and Disinfecting</u> – KDF has responded to Avian influenza outbreaks by performing: Dry Cleaning, Wet Cleaning, Dry-Ice and Heat Sterilization projects to USDA standards.

KDF developed and executed a new sterilization plan for USDA whereby we wrapped and slow-heated entire barns and purposed a plan for heat treating as a form of disinfecting the facilities. Heat sterilization was already approved but had not been applied to entire structures at that time.

<u>Biohazard Containment Protocols</u> – KDF is familiar with and proficient in Biohazard containment focusing on containing the virus to the hot zone and limiting transference off premise.

THE KDF ADVANTAGE

Flat Rate Pricing - KDF was one of the first, if not THE first, company to provide a flat rate (\$/SF) to clean and disinfect the affected areas. KDF took over another contractor's site where they were missing the deadline by months and completed the job 90% faster and more than 90% cheaper using half the personnel than the on-site contractor.
